

Frequently Asked Questions about Feast of Justice during the COVID-19 Response.

We at Feast of Justice are committed to supporting you and your family during the COVID-19 pandemic. To promote social distancing, we are giving out pre-packaged food bags to all guests and we are not allowing guests in the building. Instead, we ask that guests wait outside and your food will be brought to you. Also, we ask guests not to arrive immediately when we open because we want to eliminate big crowds and long lines for the pantry. If there is a line when you arrive at the pantry, please protect yourself and your neighbors by standing at least six feet away from others.

Can anyone get food at Feast of Justice food pantry?

Currently yes. Feast of Justice is opening their food programs to non-registered guests. However, on the **first hour** of each shift on **Wednesday and Saturday**, we are only serving registered Feast of Justice guests. This means that on Wednesday from 4 to 5 and Saturday from 1 to 2, we will only be serving registered guests. Registered guests are those that have been issued a Feast of Justice card. (Registered guests may come anytime during a shift, but the first hour of those shifts are reserved to attend to Feast of Justice guests.)

What is the City Food Relief Program? How can I get food from this program?

As a part of our response plan, we are joining forces with the city of Philadelphia as an emergency food site to help those during the COVID-19 pandemic. Food for this program will be available Mondays and Thursdays from 10am-12pm only. No ID or proof of income is required. You do **not** need to pre-register.

- Mondays: one box of non-perishable food
- Thursday: one box containing perishable food

This will take place outside our Sackett St entrance. No one will come inside the building.

Can I register to become a Guest at Feast of Justice ?

Feast of Justice can not currently register new guests.
You are welcome to register when we are able to reopen.

What do guests need to bring to the pantry?

If you are a registered guest, please bring your ID, Feast of Justice card, and bags.
Non-Registered guests should bring ID with current address. We cannot supply bags to you.

When is the pantry open during the COVID-19 Response?

Monday from 10am-noon	City Food Relief Program
Tuesday from 9am-noon	Feast of Justice Food Pantry
Wednesday from 4pm-7pm	Feast of Justice Food Pantry
Thursday from 10am-7pm	City Food Relief Program
Saturday from 1pm-4pm	Feast of Justice Food Pantry

* Please, note that during the **first hour** of each shift on **Wednesday & Saturday** we will **only** serve registered guests. Registered guests are those who have been given a Feast of Justice card.

How often can I come to the Pantry?

You may come 2 times each month for a food cupboard.

You may come as many times as you need for the City Food Relief Program.

Can I pick up food for other people?

Only guests who are on site and in line can receive food. You can't pick up a box for yourself and for someone who is not present.

Other than food, what items can I get at Feast of Justice?

Baby formula, diapers, and dog food are available upon request as supplies last.
