

Feast of Justice is remaining open for distribution of food, but in keeping with CDC recommendations, we are changing our model to help keep everyone safe.

PLEASE read carefully.
No appointments are necessary.

For Registered guests and non-registered guests

First, as a part of our response plan, we are joining forces with the city of Philadelphia as an emergency food site. Food for this program will be available Mondays and Thursdays from 10am-12pm only. No ID or proof of income is required. You do not need to pre-register. Guests will receive a box of non-perishable food and a second box containing perishable food. This will take place outside our Sackett St entrance. No one will come inside the building.

Second, we will be offering additional pre-packed food support—including meats, prepared foods, more produce, and some non-perishable supplies on Wednesdays and Saturdays. Guests can come twice a month.

- **Tuesdays**
9-10 am for guests with a Feast of Justice ID card
10am - noon for the general public
- **Wednesdays**
4-5 pm for guests with a Feast of Justice ID card
5-7 pm for the general public
- **Saturdays**
1-2 pm for Feast of Justice guests
2-4 pm for the general public.

No appointments are needed. No one will come inside the building.

Senior boxes will be available for any guests already registered and **approved** by the state. No new registrations can be taken.

At this time, we are unable to provide delivery of foods, but please check back by April 6, as we hope to begin offering that option soon.

Special Notes:

To the best of our knowledge, there are no suspected or confirmed cases of the virus in our community or amongst our staff or guests. However, we want to do all that we can to reduce the spread of the virus, protect all of those that come to Feast of Justice, and continue to provide food to families in our community.

As a part of our response plan, we will limit the assembly of large crowds in our building. We ask that everyone social distance themselves outside as well by lining up 6 feet apart.

All other Feast of Justice programs have been suspended.

New Families will not be registered at this time.

Organizations with multiple families will need to call the Feast of Justice office.

We encourage everyone to protect yourself and protect others by practicing good hygiene. We at Feast of Justice remain committed to supporting you and your family.
