Americorps VISTA Positions:

Feast of Justice has openings for FIVE Americorps VISTA members for the full 2023-2024 year. The Americorps VISTA program helps communities to enact change by supporting members that build capacity in nonprofits that work to address poverty. Members work full time for one year.

*It includes a biweekly stipend of \$880 plus an end-of-service award.

FIVE POSITIONS ARE AVAILABLE:

HFA Anti-Hunger Corps: Data and Analytics Support. This VISTA member would help to further our understanding of our hunger program outputs through analyzing data across our guest populations. Additionally, the member would help to develop and expand our inventory management system—especially as we expand our services across two locations. The member will gain experience in finding relevance in data to tell the organizational story.

HFA Anti-Hunger Corps: More Than Food Coordination. This VISTA member would assist in the development of our More than Food coaching and outreach program to empower guests to break the grip of food insecurity. This member would have an integral role in our expansion Hub location as we are collocating with 6 other social service organizations. The member will gain experience in creating a screening tool to recruit guests into the program, and connecting through intake processes.

HFA Anti-Hunger Corps: Volunteer Engagement Associate. This VISTA member would assist our Volunteer Engagement Manager in expanding the role of volunteerism at Feast of Justice. Already strong, and recently certified as a Points of Light Service Enterprise site for volunteers, this member would help us to build capacity by recruiting, communicating, training, and supporting the more than 300 volunteers we utilize annually.

PHENND Impact Alignment Coordinator. The Feast of Justice VISTA program aims to address hunger, meet needs, and inspire hope in the low-income communities of Northeast Philadelphia by building capacity of the organization and its programs. The VISTA member will analyze Community Cupboard program effectiveness through outcome assessment and alignment with nationwide models in the anti-hunger and anti-poverty spheres. By July 2024, the VISTA Impact Alignment Coordinator will build capacity by helping to better design programs and ensure the programs are having an impact beyond the provision of food.

PHENND Community Building Liaison. The Feast of Justice VISTA program aims to address hunger, meet needs, and inspire hope in the low-income communities of Northeast Philadelphia by building capacity of the organization and its programs. By July 2024, the VISTA Community Building Liaison will strengthen capacity for anti-hunger and anti-poverty work through outreach in our community, particularly focusing on a new, multi-agency expansion location that opened April 2023. The VISTA's work will involve enacting plans for outreach to residents and partners, considering models for shared service operation, and developing educational materials for the community.
