Community Cupboard, Senior Boxes and Baby Supplies, Resource Center and Individual Counseling

Community Cupboard Program

(non-perishable and perishable food packages)

Inside Shopping and Online Shopping.

Beginning March 2023

**Guests may receive food 3 times per month and only one time per week
(Monday-Sunday)**

Ending times may vary depending on availability of supplies

Guests may make ONE appointment each week and only 3 times per month. Guests with appointments should arrive at their scheduled time.

Guests without appointments should not arrive more than 30 minutes before walk-up time.

Masks are welcome but not required!

1. Please wait at the designated area when you arrive.

2. We ask that guests do not save space for others or leave carts or other objects to save their place.
3. All guests must be registered and have a Feast of Justice card. All cards will be checked, so we can track your usage of the program. All guests also need to show their photo ID. If a guest sends a proxy person to pick up food, that person must have their Photo ID.
4. There is no parking in front of the building. That space is reserved for loading food only. The driveway is a shared space and the neighbors need to use it. **Please do not park in the driveway.**
5. **Please do not leave food or boxes in the driveway or on other people's property.**

We are offering individual counseling, a resource center to help guests with booking an appointment and connecting with other outside services.

Making an Appointment for Food Distribution

Guests can make an appointment online, through either a computer or a smartphone at <https://www.feastofjustice.org/guestappointments>. Once you have requested an appointment, you will receive an email that it is pending approval. Once we confirm your eligibility, a confirmation email is sent to you. Please do not submit a second request while the confirmation is pending, we allow up to 3 weeks in advance for scheduling, so it could take 1 week before you receive a confirmation email, please be patient. The only reason you would not be approved is due to no shows in 3 weeks or if you already have an appointment for that week. You will also receive a text message reminder one day before your appointment. Further directions to make an appointment are on the website or ask a volunteer for information when you are shopping.

Senior Boxes

Senior boxes are available to those who have been approved by the state to receive a box. Guests must be 60 years old or older. and meet income level requirements. Ask a volunteer for more information or look on our website for details. This is for any family member listed in the household. The boxes are available from the 2nd through the 4th weeks of the month on a first come basis. Guests may only receive one box each month.

Baby Supplies Program

(diapers, baby supplies, and feminine products)

These are given out at distribution times.

1. Only registered Feast of Justice guests with babies listed in their registration can receive diapers and baby supplies. Guests must show their Feast of Justice registration card and it will be checked to determine the number of eligible children. There is NOT a separate line; guests will receive their diapers when they are signed in for food. You may go up to check-in to ask for them without having to wait in line if you are not receiving food.
2. Each registered child will receive one pack of diapers.
3. If you are pregnant, you may receive newborn diapers for up to 3 months before registering your newborn.
4. Adult diapers and feminine pads and products are also available upon request.

Registration or Renewing Cards

All guests are required to renew their registration every year. If you don't know when you need to renew, please check with the volunteer at the food cupboard check-in. You can find directions to complete registration on our website or ask a volunteer for information when you come for food. The Head of Household must be the person to renew their registration and must show a photo ID, date of birth and TWO items with your name and current address. Guests may email to request an appointment at registration@feastofjustice.org or in person when signing in for food.

SNAP Enrollment

The federal SNAP program helps low income families with food support at local grocery stores. Check in with us about a resource event where you can apply for SNAP on site--with bilingual counselors available to provide assistance. We hope to have a few events per year.

Volunteers

We are looking for volunteers to help with our food programs. **We especially need volunteers who are bilingual** and can help with translating during a distribution, emails, or phone calls.
