Contact our Staff Manager if you need community service hours. We can ensure you are set up in our system so that your hours will be tracked properly.

We offer volunteer opportunities for students who would like to learn new skills and need community service hours to graduate.

We offer volunteer opportunities for individuals with court mandated service hours. We reserve the right to deny any court-ordered individual the opportunity to volunteer with Feast of Justice based on the nature and specifics of their offense. Potential volunteers must provide written documentation from the court, probation officer, and/or their attorney stating the number of hours required and by what date.

Court Ordered Community Service Process:

- Our Staff Manager will review all paperwork when it is received and she will contact you stating our availability.
- We can provide a validation letter for your timesheet within two weeks of your last day. It will be written on the official letterhead stating how many hours were completed and describing job duties completed
